Packet Pick-Up

Saturday, 9 am—11 am: The HQ tent at the Lewisburg Fall Festival is across from the Bull Run Tap House. For the most stress-free experience, park at the <u>Miller Center</u> and ride to downtown. If you are looking for a closer parking area, we suggest heading south on 7th (1 block away) and look for on-street parking in the nieghborhoods.

Waivers must be signed online *before you get your number*. If you have not done this, log into <u>BikeReg</u> and sign your waiver. Anyone without a signed waiver will need to fill out a paper form (and we don't like killing trees for that).

What You Get: Each rider will get a swag bag, a number plate to go on the front of your bike), a beer or ice cream (depending on your ride), and an expertly guided ride.

Merchandise

If you pre-purchased merch it will be available in the Merchandise Ten (next to unPAved HQ) at the Fall Festival on Saturday, at the Packet Pick-Up location on Sunday morning, and under the unPAved tent at the DONEpaved Party on Sunday evening.

We will also have a great selection of new merch if you are still looking for a memory item or some fresh, warm, and styling clothes.

The FUNpaved rides are guided, no-drop rides intended to showcase the beautiful farm lands, and get you to some interesting places.

Please obey all rules of the road, wear a helmet, and use a back tail-light on these rides.

Start Location and Support

All riders (Except Ice Cream RIde) should plan to meet their group at the unPAved HQ next to the Bull Run Tap House during the Lewisburg Fall Festival. Please arrive at least 10 minutes before your ride time to get to know your group (and 30 minutes before if you need to sign-in).

The Ice Cream Ride will meet near the Bathrooms on the Rail Trail at the Miller Center. This is to avoid riding as a group across SR 15.

There are no aid stations along the rides, so please carry the needed water and snacks to get you to the end of your ride.

Rules to Follow (Pretty Please with a Whoopie Pie on Top)

1. Don't be a Dick!

We know, it's a bad word and we don't like using such language. So don't cross that line and we'll treat you with nothing but respect & love. - You may ride any bike, even an e-bike
- Course is open roads, with car & horse traffic. Abide by the rules and laws of the road, and treat cars & horses with respect. They are bigger than you.
- Safety third! Do not crash on descents! DO NOT cross the "yellow line" (mid-point of unmarked roads) especially when descending.
- FUNpaved events are not timed.
- No littering on course or in town.
- Must wear an approved helmet at all times.
- Racers must have a number affixed to the front of their bike.
