What you Get


Each rider will get a special gift bag, orange number plate, two stickers with your bib number (one for your Drop Box and one that goes on the left side of your helmet), and 3 raffle tickets, Campsite food and support, overnight parking and supply transport. You may not be racing, but there are still lots of ways to be a winner!

Your Schedule

- Packet Pick up: **Saturday, 9 am Noon** at the HQ tent at the Fall Fest located at 6th and Market. You will need to ride here from the Miller Center.
- Drop Box drop-off: **Saturday, 9 am Noon** The trailer to take your gear to camp will be located at the <u>loading dock of the Miller Center</u> in the rear of the building.
- SlumberPArty Overnight Parking Located <u>behind the Fairfield Inn</u>
- Start you ride! You have two options this year. Begin from the Miller Center after you drop your box or join the Mass Start at noon in honor of Andrea Gonzales.
- Drop Box Arrival: **Saturday, by 1 pm** The Trailer will be parked at Site 1 and left open for you to collect your supplies. You must return your box to the trailer in the morning!
- Camp set-up: Saturday, after 3 pm Your campsite won't be available until 3, so if you get there early you can drop off any packed gear you don't want on your bike at Site 1 before you ride the 30-miles of the "Burly Loop" (or you can hang out at RB Winter State Park, there's a pretty pond and beach).
- Morning Breakfast and Coffee: Sunday, 7 am 9 am Backyard Beans will be providing breakfast and coffee to fuel your return at Site 61.
- Start your ride back to the <u>Finish and DONEpaved Party</u>: **Sunday, before 10am** If you haven't ridden the 30-miles of the Gray Unicorn yet, start before 10! If you've done it or you're skipping it you have a little more time to get on your bike. But pay attention to the cut-off times on Sunday!
- Cut off Times:
 - The Ranch Aid Station by **1:30 pm**. If you get there after 1:30 you will be rerouted onto the 50-mile course. Mifflinburg is 20 miles from The Ranch.
 - Poe Paddy Aid Station by 3:30. If you get there after 3:30 you will be rerouted back to the tunnel and towards the Camp K Aid Station, which is 7 miles from Poe Paddy.

DROP BOX Allowance: You may drop 1 tote no larger than 27 GAL. (28x15) with a hard top or a sports Duffle (28x17). It is VERY IMPORTANT that this is waterproof. It may be left outside.

Use Duct Tape and Permanent Marker to include your Name and Campsite Number on your box.



Start Ceremony

This year's SlumberPArty is dedicated to Andrea Gonzales who died tragically after being struck by a car last October just weeks after attending unPAved where she and a group of friends were part of the SlumberPArty crew. Andrea was a rising community leader in Philadelphia and is greatly missed by the Philly bike scene.

There will be a mass start for the SlumberPArty riders at noon on Saturday at 6th and Market with an opening ceremony and shouts of "Vive La Bicyclette!" as you depart. Riders will cross straight across Market and follow the alleys to 7th, where you will use the light at St Mary's to cross 15 and access the Rail Trail.

The Route and Safety

We like to think that those taking on a bike-backing ride are just a little better prepared and experienced than the average racer. This is your adventure so make sure it is safe and enjoyable. On Saturday there will not be anyone out there watching. So ride in groups and make sure you have the course loaded. Be aware, that there is water at RB Winter SP, but none before. You are on your own for dinner. We will supply firewood to camps.

Fun Stuff

Campsite Assignments

We had to make a few last-minute adjustments for administrative purposes to some campsite assignments. This only affects 3 people. The Final Assignment Sheet is attached.

FIREWOOD

We are arranging for 2 bundles of firewood to be available per campsite. Campers should visit the Camp Host to collect their wood. The camp host will have the name of the first person each campsite list.

SlumberPArty Rules of the Park:

- No more than 2 unrelated people in a tent
- Respect the Site Limits assigned
- Camp and park only in designated areas
- Use local wood available to reduce invasive species.
- Clean up and pack out.
- No Beer/Alcohol allowed in PA State Parks.
- Quiet Hours are 9 pm-8 am

Finish, Rolling Recovery, and DONEpaved Party:

Finish: Even though you are not racing or timed during the event we kindly ask that you check in at the Finish Line at the Rusty Rail. Just stop and give the timer your name so we know you make it back safe—please and thank you!

Rolling Recovery: SlumberPArty riders have the luxury to return to town early and take advantage of all the yummy recovery spots. We encourage you to take your time at the Rusty Rail Brewery and enjoy the craft fair or grab a beer, maybe grab an Ice Cream at the creamery (bring your ID, credit card & some cash), or stop off at JackAss Brewery for a trailside beer along the Buffalo Valley Rail Trail. After all, you have all day to celebrate your accomplishment.

<u>DONEpaved Party</u>: You might decide you just want to be finished and head right to the Miller Center. Although the official party does not start until 5 pm, there will be stuff going on beginning at 3. When you arrive you will get a food coupon to use at one of three food establishments.
