### INFORMATION NEEDED WHEN MAKING AN EMERGENCY CALL

- Identify person as an unPAved race participant
- Name the road where the emergency has occurred
  - Or the nearest intersection or approximate distance from the nearest intersection
- Is the victim on/near the road or away from the road?
- Give the nature/best description of injury

# **EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS PLAN**

## When Calling 911

- 1. 911 will dispatch local responders based on existing protocols
- 2. 911 will notify County EMA of incident
- 3. 911 will notify DCNR if capable
- 4. County EMA will notify unPAved Command Post
- 5. unPAved Command Post will notify DCNR

# For Ham Radio Operators supporting Race Marshals

- 1. Ham Operators will contact unPAved Command Post
- 2. unPAved Command Post will contact the appropriate 911 Center directly
- 3. 911 will dispatch local responders based on existing protocols
- 4. 911 will notify County EMA of incident
- 5. unPAved Command Post will notify DCNR

- **Note:** The majority of the course is on gravel roads. No part of the course is totally inaccessible to emergency use ATVs or emergency responder 4x4s.
- Each aid station has a licensed radio operator and a medical support team there or in close proximity. It is understood that minor injuries and emergencies are likely to be addressed at the aid stations.

#### **ALTERNATE ROUTES**

#### 1. Return to Mifflinburg via Jones Mountain

- a. For Full-120 riders after doing the RB Winter section.
- b. DIRECTIONS
  - i. Turn right at the intersection of Pine Creek Rd. & Jones Mtn. Rd, instead of left to rejoin the main course.
  - ii. Go up Jones Mtn. Road, then take right onto Brandon Rd.
  - iii. At bottom, join the Proper-50 course and follow arrows to Mifflinburg
- c. It is 14 miles to Mifflinburg from start of this Alt Route. Shortens ride by 47 miles.

## 2. Left on Stony Run after The Ranch

- a. For Full-120 and Plenty-90 riders, joining the Proper-54 route.
- b. Follow their Arrows to Hobo Vista, and then to Mifflinburg.
- c. It is 19 miles to Mifflinburg from The Ranch. Shortens ride by 40 miles.

#### 3. Shortcut to Camp K

- a. For Full-120 and Plenty-90 riders, skipping the Poe Paddy Aid station.
- b. DIRECTIONS
  - i. Take right at bottom of Cherry Run on Weikert Rd. for 3.5 miles
  - ii. Take right onto White Mtn. Rd.
  - iii. Take left at T onto Weikert Run Rd. back onto course.
- c. It is 7 miles from Cherry Run to Camp K. Shortens ride by 23 miles

#### **EXTRACTION POINTS**

In case event is shortened by race officials, send riders to:

## • Hairy John Picnic Area

- o From Ranch Aid Station go left on Stony Run Rd for 2 miles.
- o Take right on Winkelblech Mountain Rd for .5 miles.
- Stay left on Winkelblech Mountain Rd for 1 mile.
- Left into Hairy John Picnic Area and find shelter in Pavillion to left.

### • Camp K Aid Station

- o From Poe Paddy Aid Station go back to tunnel and rail trail.
- After Rail Trail stay straight on Weikert Run Rd. for 3.5 miles
- o Take right onto White Mtn. Rd.
- Take left at T onto Weikert Run Rd. back onto course.
- Stop at Camp K Aid Station and find shelter.
- Distance from Poe Paddy to Camp K: 11 miles
